The balance of my property I give and bequeath to my grand children the children of my daughter Mary to be divided equally amongst them to have and hold forever

I nominate and appoint T.A. Quinn and C.H. Shillito to be the executors of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former wills by me made in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this seventh day of October A.D. 1893

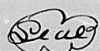
